## Teachers' Activity Worksheet

1. Without telling the children anything about the portrait, ask them to look at the image in small groups and answer a series of questions on the first portrait worksheet. The groups should then share their thoughts and ideas with the rest of the class.

2. Once the children have discussed their ideas, ask them to read the information provided about George Brown. This information will reveal that George Brown made his money from the Transatlantic slave trade.
