Author of *Under the Volcano*, **Malcolm Lowry** was born in 1909 in New Brighton on the Wirral. To celebrate the centenary of his birth, the Bluecoat organised an exhibition, titled after his famous book, and an extensive season of music, dance, talks, walks, and other events in 2009. A book, *Malcolm Lowry: From the Mersey to the World*, was published by Liverpool University Press to coincide with this.

Each year since then a group of Lowry enthusiasts from Merseyside and the North of England, The Firminists, have held an event in Liverpool exploring aspects of the writer's life and work.

This year's Lowry Lounge comprises a psychogeographical walking tour of Liverpool with artist Colin Dilnot and an afternoon programme including the launch of Lowry journal *The Firminist* No 3, performances, talks, films and music.
