Remade and Relocated - Malcolm Lowry's Shack at Dollarton, Vancouver (1940)

A 1/50 scale model, of Malcolm Lowry's shack on the Dollarton shoreline that he purchased for £100 in 1940. This model will later form the basis for a photographic work, ultimately to be displayed in a lightbox. This and other works will form part of an installation that will also feature a neon, text-based piece, which makes references to the Shellburn Oil Refinery facing the squatters' shacks on the far side of the Burrard Inlet.
