After the coach tour, back at Bluecoat there is a screening of one of Lowry's favourite films, *Outward Bound* at 3pm. This is followed by the launch of University of Ottawa Press' new publication, *The 1940 Under the Volcano by Malcolm Lowry: A Critical Edition*, Lowry's first attempt at writing his best known book, which differs significantly from his 1947 masterpiece. This part of the Lounge, starting at 5pm, is free but if you are only coming for this booking is still recommended. Lowry scholar **Vik Doyen**, who has written a foreword to the book, will introduce the new edition and talk about the process of bringing it to publication
