The Executive Committee by virtue of the control given to them over the election of members by Rule 12 (a) of the Rules of the Society and in pursuance of their powers to make Bye-Laws for the management of the Society under Rule 27 (a) of the Rules of the Society, enact the following bye-law, which shall be numbered Bye-Law No.4 and shall come into force forthwith:-

and seconding of a candidate for election to the Society under categories a,b,c and d of Rule 3 referred to in Rule 12 (b) of the Rules of the Society, shall not be given to any member of the Society for the purpose of proposing or seconding any candidate for election to the Society unless such member shall have received the prior verbal consent of four members of the Executive Committee to the proposing and seconding of a candidate for election and the proposer or seconder, shall, before sending the official form to the Honorary Secretary, in pursuance of Rule 12 (b) of the Rules of the Society, and in addition to the requirements of the Tule, place on the back of the said form the names of the members of the Executive Committee, whose consent has been obtained in accordance with the afore-mentioned requirements.
